## The Church

### Unit Overview

#### Lesson 1 God, Our Father

Scripture Memory Verse:

#### Lesson 2 Our Family

Scripture Memory Verse:

Acts 4:32

*All the believers shared everything they had.*

The children will learn that the church is a family created by God. They will meet a leader from their congregation. They will see that God takes care of his family in the same way that he takes care of their physical family.

#### Lesson 4 God's Leaders

Scripture Memory Verse:

Hebrews 13:7

*Remember your leaders, imitate their faith.*

God has given us leaders in the church to help us to be our best. The children will meet another leader from their congregation. They will make gifts to thank those that lead them for all of the hard work that they do for God's church.

#### Lesson 3 God's Family

Scripture Memory Verse:

Acts 4:32

*All the believers shared everything they had.*

In the first century church the disciples were like one big family. They shared everything that they had. The children will practice sharing and will talk about ways that they can share all that God has given them.

#### Lesson 5 Leaders Care For Us

Scripture Memory Verse:

Hebrews 13:7

*Remember your leaders, imitate their faith.*

The children will learn that God wants us to help those around us who are in need. They will hear about how the widows were taken care of by the first-century disciples. The children will make a box to collect food items for those in need in their communities.
