

# Unit 12 at a Glance

## God Knows Me

### Unit Overview

In this unit the children will learn of David and his bravery in defending his sheep. Through his example, and that of Paul and Philip, they will see that God loves us and wants us to be brave. The children will see that like Paul, they can trust God and do what is right. By their actions they will make God happy as well as themselves.

### Unit Goals

- The children will learn that Paul was a man who preached even though he was afraid.
- The children will name things that they are afraid of and ways that they can trust God to take care of them.
- The children will list ways that God makes them happy.

### Unit Contents

#### Lesson 1 God Made Me

Scripture Memory Verse:

Psalm 139:14

*I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made.*

The Bible says that God took great care in making each one of us. The children will learn that God created them to be special. They will learn the basic functions of their body parts.

#### Lesson 2 He Protects Me

Scripture Memory Verse:

Psalm 139:14

*I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made.*

God always knows what our needs are. He loves us and wants to protect us just as he protected David. God gave David the strength to fight against a lion and a bear in order to save his sheep. The children will learn that God protects them too. They will thank God for taking good care of them.

#### Lesson 3 How I Feel

Scripture Memory Verse:

Acts 18:9

*"Do not be afraid; keep on speaking, do not be silent."*

There are many things that can make us afraid. God gives us the strength we need to overcome our fears. Paul had to overcome his fears when he preached about Jesus. The children will learn about Paul and his trust in God. They will list things that they are afraid of and how they can trust in God to be brave.

#### Lesson 4 God Makes Me Happy

Scripture Memory Verse:

Acts 18:9

*"Do not be afraid; keep on speaking, do not be silent."*

God loves to make us happy. The children will learn how God used Philip to make the Ethiopian happy. They will see that we are happy when we have a relationship with God. They will name other ways that God makes them happy.
